OPENING

Open with a song or video that connects with today's theme like:

"Light of the World" by Hillsong Kids

"Let your Light Shine" by Hillsong Kids

"He's got the Whole World in His Hands" by Lifetree Kids

GAME: Pass the Globe

Form a circle with the children. Give them a small globe (or a ball if a globe isn't available). Play some music and have the children pass the globe around the circle. When the music stops, the child holding the globe shares one thing they love about the world or one way they can show love to others. Then, start the music again and continue until everyone has had a turn.

THE BIBLE STORY: Hebrews 1:1-4

Review the memory verse from Hebrews 1:3 (CEB).

Pause for the children to repeat each line:

"The Son (Jesus) is the light of God's glory and the imprint of God's being."

If the children's message was not already heard, share it now.

CRAFT: Global Prayer Chain

Materials Needed:

- Strips of colored paper
- markers
- string or yarn

Instructions:

- 1. Ask each child to choose a country that they will create a prayer link for.
- 2. Give each child a strip of paper and ask them to write down a prayer for students in the country they selected.
- 3. After they've written their prayers, help them connect the strips of paper together to form a long chain.
- 4. Hang the prayer chain in the classroom or around the church as a reminder to pray for people all around the world.
